

General Instructions

All submitters must be Current members of the AARV in good standing and be Credentialed Veterinary Technicians.

The case should be presented in PowerPoint format and should accurately document case assessment and management in a problem-oriented manner. There should be appropriate visual aids to support the case discussion and illustrate key educational points. These visual aids may include figures, charts, pictures, video clips, and sound files, among others. Presenters must have signed a photo release using the [AARV photo release document](#)

Information on slides should be clear and easy to read. Bullet points are encouraged where appropriate. Sufficient discussion should be included within the slides to provide a clear understanding of the information that is presented, especially as it relates to diagnostic and therapeutic decision-making processes.

All case report presentations must be prepared using this AARV design template and contain:

- 1 Title Slide
- 10-15 Body Slides
- 1 Summary Slide

Review/Scoring

The AARV Board of Directors will review all PowerPoint case presentations. Decisions regarding winners and inclusion of the case report on the AARV Fall CE and website will be made based on the following:

- Scientific and medical validity.
- Educational value and practicality of the information.
- Organization and logic in the presentation format.
- Thoroughness of the discussion.
- Inclusion of necessary and appropriate visual aids.

Winners will be decided, and all applicants informed, no later than September 12th, 2025.
